# **History Taking**

Intention kinetic tremors

Unsteadiness of gait

Stacatto speech

Nystagmus

## **History Taking**

- The condition was also associated with AIMs that are absent during rest, occur on action, increase on approaching the target.
- The condition is also associated with unsteadiness of gait with deviation to either side.
- The condition is also associated with difficulty in articulation despite good communication.


### **Examination of Coordination**

#### **Upper limb**

- Finger to nose, to finger, to doctor finger. Assess decomposition, intention tremors and dysmetria.
- Dysdiadokokinesia
- Rebound phenomena
- Buttoning and unbuttoning

#### **Lower limb**

- Heel to knee test
- Walking straight
- Romberg test
















To keep her balance the child with ataxia walks bent forward with feet wide apart. She takes irregular steps, like a sailor on a rough sea or someone who is drunk.
